RESOLUTION NO. R – 04 – 18 – 27

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A STAFF INCREASE OF ONE FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER POSITION TO THE CLAYTON POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 5 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Clayton and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (Patrol Officers), management maintains the right to determine the size and composition of the work force; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, the City finds it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the City, the citizens of Clayton, and the public at large to increase the staffing of the Police Department by one full time police officer in order to, among other things, continue support of the Northmont School Resource Program, stabilize staffing schedules, and continue to effectively respond to calls for service which have increased by 9% over the last three years.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:


1. That the City of Clayton does hereby authorize and approve a staff increase of one full time police officer position to the Clayton Police Department.
2. That City Staff is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take all action necessary to effect such staffing change and evidence same on the books and records of the City.


