A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR REQUESTED FUNDING FOR THE HOKE ROAD AND SR 49 INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND FOR THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the OPWC State Capital Improvement Program provides financial assistance in the form of grants to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clayton is planning to make capital improvements associated with the Hoke Road and SR 49 Infrastructure Improvement Project for the replacement of curbs, medians, catch basins and supporting infrastructure along Salem Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:


1. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC State Capital Improvement Program for grant funds as described above.


